The format for the MSCCS Super Late Models will be as follows:

Qualify with the Top 8 transferring to a Dash

Positions 9 thru 20 will be filled from the B-Mains

Dash – will determine the starting of the top 8 in the main event.

Positions 21 and 22 will be determined from the top 15 in points from 2021 listed below
